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My ride height is 4" and I run Hoosier C3000 23.0x9.5-15 cantilever slicks with a tread width of 9.2" for Autox. I only had problems on take off. But I was running the stock torsion bars. I went to a 28 mm torsion bar and solved the problem. So I would think 60s would be fine.
